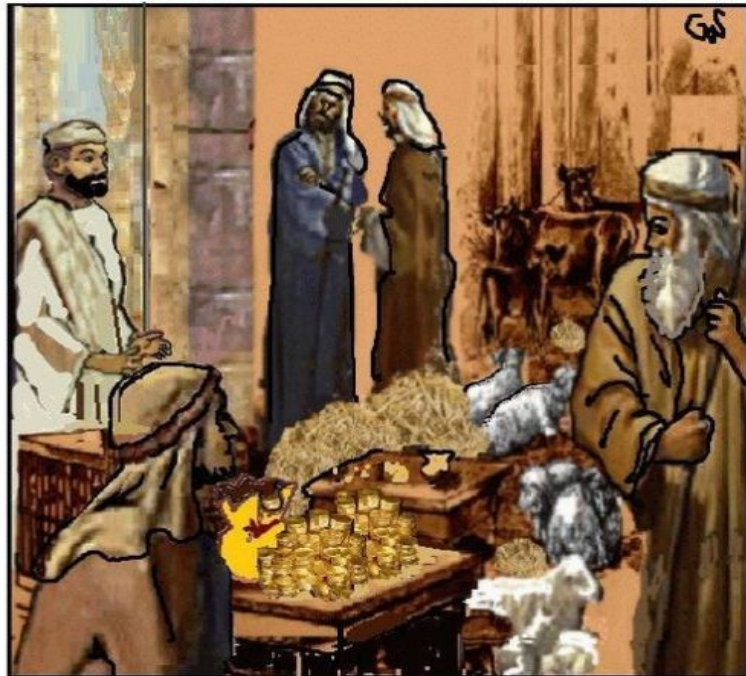
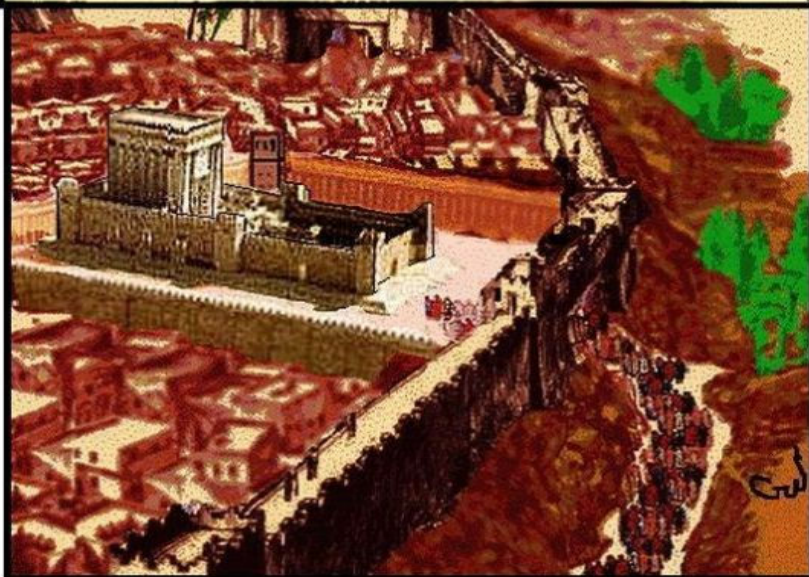


It was the first Passover Feast during Jesus' ministry and He was in Jerusalem at the Temple...
