1. Arrange association with people with things in common.

2. (Acts 10:35) "But in every nation whoever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him."

(**James 2:5**) "Listen, my beloved brethren: Has God not chosen the poor of this world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom which He promised to those who love Him?

P "I DON'T LIKE THE PREACHER"

1. <u>Why? Doesn't he preach the truth?</u> Do you really <u>know him?</u>

2. <u>Worship God.</u>(1 Cor. 2:5) "that your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God."

(1 Cor. 4:6) " that you may learn in us not to think beyond what is written, that none of you may be puffed up on behalf of one against the other."

ypocrites "I KNOW SO MANY HYPOCRITES IN THE CHURCH'

1. Yes--Judas, Peter, many today-but do you see some good?

2. <u>Are you without sin?</u> (1 John 1:8-9) If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

(**Matthew 7:1-5**) "Judge not, that you be not judged. "For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged; ..."

hurch "I DON'T THINK I HAVE TO GO TO CHURCH TO BE A CHRISTIAN'

1. <u>Must one love the Lord to be saved?</u> (John 14:15) "If you love Me, keep My commandments." (John 15:14) "You are My friends if you do whatever I command you."

2. <u>We are to assemble</u>. -<u>Worship</u> (Heb. 10:25) "not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together," – (Ephesians 5:19) "speaking to one another in psalms..."; (Heb. 2:12) saying: "I will declare Your name to My brethren; In the midst of the assembly I will sing praise to You."

1. <u>We want you to make a change</u> (commend honesty). (Acts 8:22) "Repent therefore of this your wickedness, and pray God if perhaps the thought of your heart may be forgiven you.

2. What if you die in sin now?


(John 8:21) "Then Jesus said to them again, "I am going away, and you will seek Me, and will die in your sin. Where I go you cannot come."

H usband "MY HUSBAND OBJECTS TO MY GOING TO CHURCH EVERY SUNDAY"

1. <u>Can he save you or answer for you at Judgment?</u> (Matthew 10:37-38) 'He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me. "And he who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me"

2. You are expected to obey as fit in the Lord. (Colossians

3:18) "Wives, submit to your own husbands, as is fitting in the Lord."

1. [Find out if he has a (religious) hobby. Remind him that he may offer suggestions.]

2. <u>Elders have the duty to oversee.</u> (1 Peter 5:1-3) The elders who are among you I exhort... Shepherd the flock of God which is among you, serving as overseers, not by compulsion but willingly, not for dishonest gain but eagerly; nor as being lords over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock;

ffended "ONE OF THE MEMBERS OFFENDED ME. CAN'T WORSHIP IF HE ATTENDS"

1. <u>Have you gone to him?</u> (Matthew 18:15-17) "Moreover if your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he hears you, you have gained your brother. "But if he will not hear, take with you one or two more, that 'by the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.' "And if he refuses to hear them, tell it to the church."

2. Duty to worship God:(Matthew 4:10) 'You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only you shall serve.'"

arrow minded "CHURCH IS TOO NARROW MINDED"

1. <u>On what subject?</u> (Matthew 7:13-14) "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. "Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.

2. <u>Do you believe the Bible?</u> (Romans 3:3-4)' For what if some did not believe? Will their unbelief make the faithfulness of God without effect? Certainly not! Indeed, let God be true but every man a liar. As it is written: "That You may be justified in Your words..."
